 - a Director Report: May Day celebration is coming up on Tuesday. All are welcome to join us. The listening sessions are under way, with 2 more coming up the first part of May.
 - b Education Program Committee: 4/5's have completed their projects, 2/3 are coming up on May Day, and the k/1 team will have their project fair on 5/4. From a tech side the MCA's have gone very smoothly. We will finish up tomorrow with the majority of the

Technology

The Tech committee is pleased with how smoothly the first week of MCA testing has been. The Chromebooks and carts have made it much easier and we really appreciate Bob and Josh from Canopy IT Solutions for improving our network to handle so many computers running at once. We have used almost all of the remaining tech budget on MacBook Airs for staff as we are hoping to have all teachers with newer computers by next year as well as many of the other staff. This is a cycle that we began two years ago so that we wouldn't need to purchase laptops for everyone at once. Josh (Canopy IT) also led a very successful 30-minute professional development at the staff meeting to help teachers be more comfortable with technology and maintaining their laptops.

Wellness Committee Update: The committee met for the last time this school year on April 4. We mostly discussed 3 items: we've talked about having a local dentist come out annually for oral health education for all K/1's. Connie Menssen will follow up on that to get it started fall 2018.
