Prairie Creek Community School 2020-2021 **K-1** Supply List

The supply list looks different this year. We typically have community supplies that the children share, but to ensure health safety, we ask that your child has their own personal supplies which should be labeled. These supplies will be used in any of the possible scenarios (in-person, hybrid, distance learning).

<u>Individual student supplies (for all scenarios)</u>, label items that you can with your child's name and/or place in labeled ziploc bag:

- A backpack (standard size and shape to accommodate materials up to 9x12). Be mindful of winter time when it will need to hold books, folders, and winter clothes.
- One pair of closed-toe shoes to be worn indoors at school and suitable for running in the gym. These shoes are referred to as "indoor shoes" and will stay at school (Tennis shoes with Velcro or elastic laces work best.) Your child <u>must be able to change shoes independently</u>.
- 1 box (12 count) of Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 set of Crayola markers (broad line)
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (any count)
- 1 pair of kid's Fiskars blunt-tip scissors
- 1 bottle of white school glue (4 oz size)
- glue sticks (Elmer's brand preferred)
- 2 spiral notebooks (70 sheets, wide ruled)
- 4 pocket folders (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 orange). No prongs, if avoidable.
- Play-Doh
- Black sharpies (1 fine point, 1 ultra-fine point)
- 8-count watercolor paints with brush (we recommend Prang)
- A few pieces of sidewalk chalk
- A few sheet protectors (for 8 ½ x 11 paper)
- 2 or more Expo dry erase markers (chisel tip or fine tip), low odor
- Pencil pouch/case to hold supplies
- 1 simple pencil sharpener

Additional Supplies for in-person or hybrid scenarios, label with your child's name:

- An extra set of clothing in a labeled Ziploc bag (include pants, shirt, underwear and socks)
- Beach towel (for use during outside learning)
- Rain pants and rain jacket (or full body rain suit) and rain boots

<u>Additional Supplies</u>, <u>NOT</u> to be labeled (These will be needed in the classroom. Donating some of these items would be helpful, if you are able):

- 1 ream of white printer paper
- 8 ½ x 11 white cardstock
- 1 box of quart-size or gallon-size Ziploc bags (with slider close) or Hefty Jumbo bags (2.5 gal)
- 1 box of facial tissues (any brand)
- Assorted craft supplies (craft sticks, beads, feathers, pipe cleaners, scrap fabric, etc.)
- Tape: masking tape / scotch tape (dispenser refills are fine) / colored duct tape
- Watercolor paper
